

MOBILE PHONES & ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

At Brisbane Christian College all of our children have access to IT and digital resources to assist them in their learning and education in the classroom. There is no need for children to bring mobile phones or smart watches to the College for educational purposes.

It is acknowledged that many of our children now carry these devices for added security for before and after school. Where this is the case, children must not have a phone or smart watch on their person once the school day has commenced. In Primary School, the devices must be handed in at Student Services at the College Office for the duration of the school day.

Mobile phones and smart devices sighted during the school day, whether during class time or break time, will be removed from the child and returned to them at the completion of the day. A child who repeatedly does not comply with this policy, will have their devices removed and their parent contacted to collect it. Where a parent wishes to get in contact with their child during the school day, they can continue to do so by calling the College Office. Where a child wishes to contact their parent, they can also continue to do so via the College phones.
